

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

From Monday October 17th through Tuesday October 18th, The Hoffman Research Group surveyed a cross section of Oregon voters to ascertain their preferences in the upcoming 2022 Oregon Gubernatorial Election.

The survey has a margin of error of plus or minus 3.8% at a 95% confidence level. The survey is based on landline and cellphone interviews with 684 randomly chosen likely voters in Oregon. Attention was given to Oregon's rural and urban divide within seven geographic regions. The survey also maintained appropriate balances with regard to age, gender, and vote propensity.

The Hoffman Research Group, a division of Gateway Communications Inc., is an independent polling firm headquartered in Portland, OR, and has conducted hundreds of political tracking surveys and market research projects since 1984.
