Count 01: ORS 475.860(2) DELIVERY OF MARIJUANA FOR CONSIDERATION(B Felony)

Count 02: ORS 163.275 COERCION(C Felony)

Count 03: ORS 163.547 CHILD NEGLECT IN THE FIRST DEGREE(B Felony)

Count 04: ORS 163.575 ENDANGERING THE WELFARE OF A MINOR(A Misdemeanor)

committed as follows:

COUNT 01 The defendant, on or about January 17, 2011, in Marion County, Oregon, did unlawfully and knowingly deliver for consideration marijuana, a controlled substance.

It is further alleged that the above-described conduct was a commercial drug offense due to the following factors: The above-described delivery was for consideration;

The defendant was in possession of materials being used for the packaging of controlled substances;

The defendant was in possession of a dangerous or deadly weapon as defined in ORS 161.015 for the purpose of using it in connection with this offense.

COUNT 02 In an act of the same or similar character and in an act connected with, or constituting part of a scheme or plan common to Count 1 above, the defendant, on or about January 17, 2011, in Marion County, Oregon, did unlawfully and knowingly compel Veronica Navarro to engage in conduct from which Veronica Navarro had a legal right to abstain, to wit: apologize, by means of instilling in Veronica Navarro a fear that if Veronica Navarro refrained from the conduct compelled, defendant would engage in conduct constituting the crime of Kidnapping.

COUNT 03 In an act of the same or similar character and in an act connected with, or constituting part of a scheme or plan common to Count 1 and Count 2 above, the defendant, on or about January 17, 2011, in Marion County, Oregon, having custody and control of Ramiro Navarro Jr., a child under 16 years of age, did unlawfully and knowingly allow the child to stay in a vehicle where controlled substances were being criminally delivered.
