() IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the show cause is withdrawn/dismissed.

NOW, THEREFORE; IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- The defendant's probation is revoked.
- Defendant shall be committed to the custody of the Oregon State Department of Corrections/ Marion County Supervisory Authority for 2 months. The length of post-prison supervision shall be 24 months. The Supervisory Authority may impose sanctions other than incarceration. If defendant violates the conditions of post-prison supervision, the defendant shall be subject to sanctions including additional imprisonment.
- Defendant IS/IS NOT eligible for good time, work time, emergency leave, or other early release based upon substantial, compelling reasons as stated in the record.
- DOC may release the defendant on post-prison supervision under ORS 421.508(4)
- Defendant shall be committed to the custody of the Marion County Jail for _____ days.
- Defendant shall NOT receive credit for time served in Marion County Jail: () as part of the probationary sentence previously imposed: () awaiting commencement of the probationary sentence.
- The incarceration shall be served CONSECUTIVELY with: () any sentence previously imposed: () _____.

MONEY AWARD:

- All fines originally suspended are now imposed and remain owing after revocation.
- Pay court-appointed attorney fees in the amount of \$ 230, less any previously court-ordered contribution.
- Pay \$25 probation violation fee.
- Defendant shall pay financial obligations, including restitution & attorney fees, ordered by the sentencing court at a rate set by the Supervisory Authority/State Board of Parole & Post-Prison Supervision upon release from incarceration.
- Defendant's probation shall be continued/modified on the same terms and conditions as previously ordered, plus the following additional conditions
 - Defendant shall serve _____ days in the Marion County Jail, () without credit for time served. Defendant shall report immediately/by _____.
 - Defendant shall perform _____ additional hours community service at direction of _____.
 - Pay \$25 probation violation fee.
